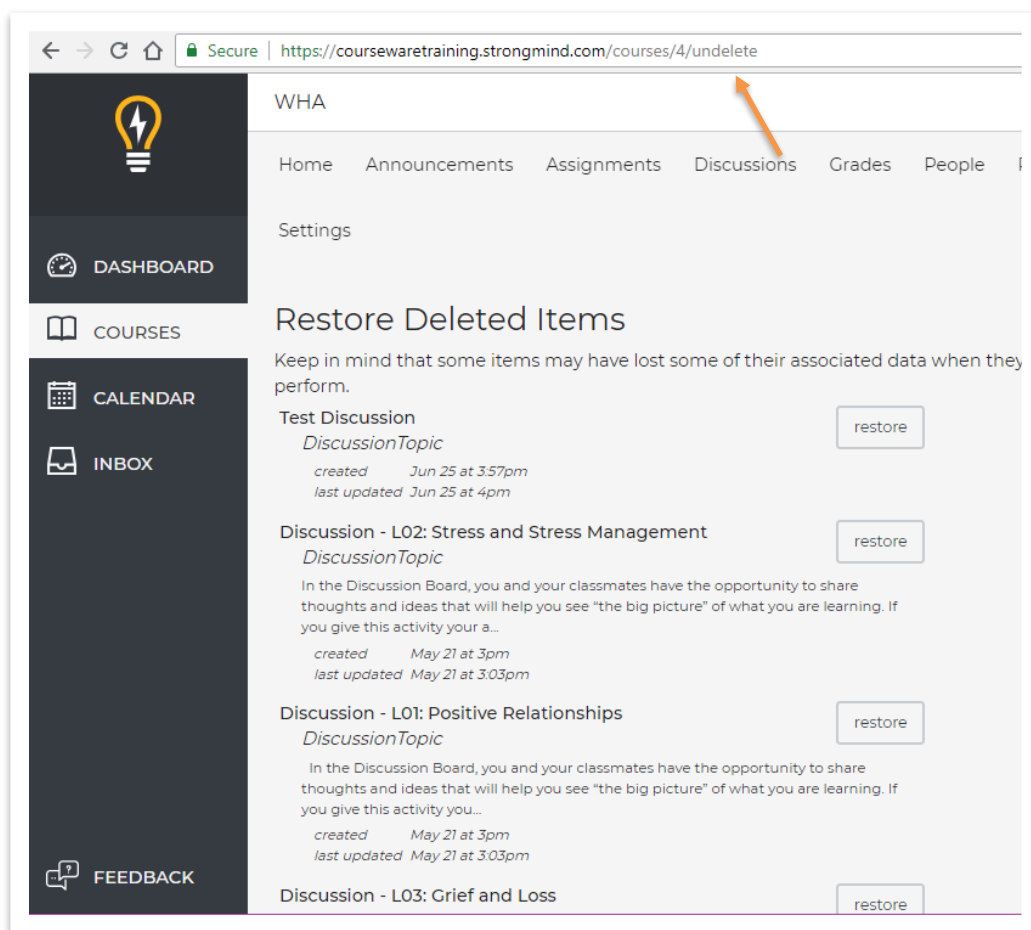


If content has been deleted from a course, Courseware offers a way to view and restore deleted content. The Undelete screen will display the most recent restorable entries from the course. Please note that this feature does have limits and is not 100% supported, thus it is suggested that this feature is not heavily relied on.

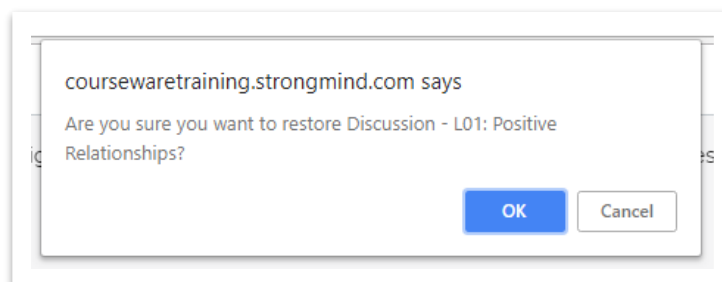
Limitations:

- Only the last 25 items will appear in the restore list.
- Restoring assignments or discussions with student submissions will not restore the submissions.

1. Navigate to the **Home** menu of the desired course.
2. Locate the URL in the address bar of the browser, which shows the exact location within Courseware.
3. Add **"/undelete"** to the end of the URL in the address bar (after the course ID number) and press the Enter key.
 - a. Example: <https://schoolname.strongmind.com/courses/251/undelete>



- If content should be restored, click **restore** next to the item. A validation message will appear requesting confirmation to restore the item. Click **OK** to proceed.



- When an item is restored, it can be located in either the **Assignments** menu or **Discussions** menu, depending on the item type.
 - Note:** The restored item will be unpublished and will need re-published and re-inserted within the Modules if students should access in the module navigation.
